
How to explain the disease to Hugo and his friends?








 $\checkmark$  The skin is dry. You can tell when you touch it.


✓ There are red patches, especially in the folds of the skin : neck, elbows, back of the knees, wrists and behind the ears, etc.



The patches are itchy and make you want to scratch a lot, even at night.

✓ In the morning, sometimes Hugo is sleepy, doesn't feel well and is often worried.





## Teacher, where does eczema come from?

✓ It often starts with dry, red patches on babies' cheeks.



 $\checkmark$  It's a skin reaction that is too strong to various types of dust in the house or animal fur or plant pollens, etc.



 $\checkmark$  Often, there are other people in the family whose nose, eyes or lungs are sensitive to this dust. We say they are allergic.

The family is the mother, father, brothers and isters. Not all young children with eczema have allergic families.







✓ The skin is dry:



#### ✓ The skin is red:

- We say it is inflamed. Anti-inflammatory ointments that are very effective have to be spread over the patches.
  - These anti-inflammatory ointments are based on cortisone and are called "dermocorticosteroids".

# Teacher, does Hugo have to take precautions?

#### ✓ When you have eczema, heat bothers you:

- You have to avoid having wool directly touch your skin and turtlenecks that make your neck itch.
- The bedroom and classroom will be aired out in the morning and at night.
- At school, Hugo will sit far away from the radiator.

#### ✓ When you have eczema, some soaps both you:

 There are non-aggressive soaps, referred to as detergent-free, that are soft for the skin.

Next to the skin, wear cotton clothing

and take showers rather than baths.

#### ✓ Sports, of course, are authorized:

• Sports are followed by a quick shower if you've perspired a lot.






## Teacher, can it be cured?

✓ Of course, many children are cured before they turn six.

✓ For others, creams and ointments are very effective.

✓ Finally, some are fragile, not just in terms of their skin, but also their eyes, nose and lungs. They are "allergic".







Teacher, what is asthma?

 Asthma is a bronchial disease, which affects the tubes that bring air to your lungs.

✓ With asthmatics, you can't tell, but the inside of the bronchial tracts is red, inflamed and the child coughs a lot.

 The child's bronchial tracts are sensitive to tobacco smoke, dust in mattresses and pillows, and pollution.
